
U.S. Election Assistance Commission CARES Act Grants Audit Summary

In March 2020, Congress appropriated

\$400 million

under the CARES Act (Pub. L. 116-136) for states to address the effects of the pandemic on the 2020 election cycle.

37.5% of the grants were audited by OIG



Amounts include federal funds received and any state matching funds or interest earned at the time of audit.

Audits found internal control issues that were generally consistent with other types of EAC grants.
